## TEAM CAPTAINS

- Teams of people camp out at a local high school, & take turns walking around a track.
- Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event.
- Relay is an overnight event, up to 24 hours in length.
- The event brings communities together to learn about and raise money for the fight against cancer. **Research – Education - Advocacy - Service**
- As a Team Captain, you are responsible for recruiting walkers and runners and making the connection between them and your local American Cancer Society office (through Howe High School) you are the heart and soul of Relay For Life.
